
Questions

Questions

Verses 1-14, referencing signs of the day of judgement.

2. What is meant in verse 7: and when the souls 'and their bodies' are paired 'once more?

Referencing the resurrection on the day of judgement

- **3.** Verse 8 mentions female infanticide. Why is this relevant to mention? This was a practice that was performed by pagan Arabs at the time of the Prophet
- **4.** On what day is verse 14 referring to? The day of judgement when every person will know what he has brought
- 5. In the middle of the Surah, the Surah swears upon how many things? What are they?

Three things: planets, night and dawn (verses 15-18)

- 6. The Surah clarifies who's word is and is not the Quran. What does it say?
- 19. Verily, this is the Word (this Qur'an brought by) a most honourable messenger [Jibrael (Gabriel), **from Allah** to the Prophet Muhammad (🎉)].
- 25. And it (the Qur'an) is not the word of the outcast Shaitan (Satan).
 - 7. What is the purpose of the Quran mentioned at the end of the Surah?

Verse 27: Verily, this (the Qur'an) is no less than a Reminder to (all) the 'Alamin (mankind and jinns).
