

- Islam
 - "Peace through submission to God"
- Allah
 - "Arabic word for God, also used for Arab Christians"
- Muslim Greeting
 - "As-Salaam Alaikum" = Peace be upon you



The basic beliefs of Islam are simple

- Unity and Justice of God
- Angels
- Prophets
- Holy Books
- Day of Judgment
- Equality of all people before God



Islamic values are common to most religions

- Enjoining the Good, forbidding the Evil
- Self exertion: urged to strive and act
- Pursuing social justice and fairness
- Humility and modesty
- Importance of family as basic social unit
- Pursuing truth and knowledge
- Worshipping God and serving humanity


Islam originated in 7th Century Arabia

- Makkah was center for idolatry in Arabia
- Prophethood of Muhammad
- Persecution of early Muslims
- Reformation of prevailing pagan society in Makkah
- Conversion and union of Arabia under Islam
- Spread outward to Middle East, Asia, and Africa



Muslims believe that Muhammad was "the seal of the prophets"

- Lived 570-632 A.D.
- Descended from Prophet Abraham, part of ruling Quraysh tribe in Makkah
- Merchant known for honesty & trustworthiness
- First revelation, 610 A.D.
- Numerous attempts to bribe and assassinate him
- Persecuted, fled Makkah to Madinah in 622
- Temporal and spiritual leader of early Muslim community



61:6 And remember, Jesus, the son of Mary, said: "O Children of Israel! I am the apostle of God (sent) to you, confirming the Law (which came) before me, and giving Glad Tidings of an Messenger to come after me, whose name shall be Ahmad..."

Muslims believe that the Qur'an itself is a miracle


76:23 It is We Who have sent down the Qur'an to thee by stages.

17:88 Say: "If the whole of mankind were to gather together to produce the like of this Qur'an, they could not produce the like thereof, even if they backed up each other with help and support.

10:37 This Qur'an is not such as can be produced by other than God. On the contrary it is a confirmation of (revelations) that went before it, and a fuller explanation of the Book - wherein there is no doubt - from the Lord of the worlds.







36:69 We have not instructed the (Prophet) in Poetry, nor is it meet for him: this is no less than a Message and a Qur'an making things clear

Except those who believe and do good deeds, enjoin each other with truth, and enjoin on each other patience and constancy



Islamic practices common to all majority of Muslims

- Shahadah
 - Declaration of faith
- Salat:
 - Ritual prayer 5 times a day
- Zakat:
 - Giving to charity (minimum of 2.5% of wealth annually)
- Sawm:
 - Fasting during the month of Ramadan
- Hajj:
 - Pilgrimage to Mecca, for those who can afford the journey



What is the significance of the month of Ramadhan? Purifying the conscience through fasting...

- Ninth month of the Islamic calendar
 - Lunar calendar shifts 12 days relative to the solar calendar each year. This year Ramahdan started on Nov. 6th and will likely end on Dec. 6th
- The Qur'an was revealed in this month
 - A time to read the Qur'an, reflect on your actions, and ask for forgiveness and guidance
- Abstaining from food, drink, smoking, and sex between sunrise to sunset
- As important is to stay away from lying, hurting another's feelings...
 - "Hear no evil, see no evil, do no evil"
- The end of Ramadhan is celebrated with the Eid holiday


2:183 O ye who believe! Fasting is prescribed to you as it was prescribed to those before you, that ye may (learn) self-restraint.

2:185 The month of Ramadhan is that in which the Qur'an was revealed, a guidance to men and clear proofs of the guidance and the distinction; therefore whoever of you is present in the month, he shall fast therein, and whoever is sick or upon a journey, then (he shall fast) a (like) number of other days; God desires ease for you, and He does not desire for you difficulty...and that you may give thanks.

2:186 And when My servants ask you concerning Me, then surely I am very near; I answer the prayer of the suppliant when he calls on Me, so they should answer My call and believe in Me that they may walk in the right way



- Medicine/Anatomy aorta, cornea, pancreas, colon










Islamic art and architecture emphasizes geometric and calligraphic designs

Islam is the fastest growing religion in the West

- Growing due to immigration and conversion
- Large Muslim minorities in the United Kingdom, Germany, and France
- Between 4-7 million Muslims in the United States
- More awareness post-September 11th
- Often misunderstood in the West







Islam is misunderstood in the West – at every level of society

- Jihad Literally means struggle. No such term as "holy war" in Islam
- Women Are not oppressed in Islam. Have equal rights terms of property, inheritance, education...
- Islam and other religions Not intolerant of other faiths. Special respect for Abrahamic faiths
- Muslim does not mean Arab. Most Muslims are not Arab
- Islam is not anti-Western
- All terrorists are not Muslims
- Sharia Law does not mean stoning and chopping off of hands
